

Transport statistics

July 2017

Tirana, 28 August 2017: The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in July is 372 thousand / tonnes. Compared with July 2016, this indicator increased by 24.6 %.

In the seven months of 2017, the volume of freight loading/unloading in ports is 2,319 thousand/tonnes, increasing by 9.4 % compared to the same period of year 2016.

Durrës port occupies 88.0 %, all loaded/unloaded goods in all ports.

The volume of goods transported by rail is 1.7 million tonnes-km, increasing 115.3 compared to July 2016.

In the seven months of 2017, volume of freights transported by rail is 14 million tonnes-km and increased by 166.4 % compared with the same period of 2016.

In July 2017, the volume of freights transported by air is 188 tonnes, increasing by 9.9 % compared with the same month of year 2016.

In the seven months of 2017, the volume of freight transported is 13,236 tonnes, increasing by 10.8 % compared to the same period of year 2016.

In July 2017, number of flights is 2,496, marking an increase of 19.0%, compared to July 2016.

In seven of 2017, are concluded 10,742 flights, marking an increase of 9.0 % compared to the same period of year 2016.

In July 2017, the number of passengers traveling with airline is 293,064, increasing by 31.2 % compared to July 2016.

Passenger transport by air during this period occupies 65.7 % of the total of passengers travelled. The number of passengers traveling by air in the seven months of 2017 is 1,413,390 persons, increasing by 24.1 % compared to the same period of year 2016.

The number of passengers travelling by maritime line is 232,530 persons compared to July 2016, this indicator increased by 23.1 %.

The number of passengers travelling by maritime line during the seven months of 2017 is 699,064 increasing by 19.8 % compared to the same period of the previous year.

Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

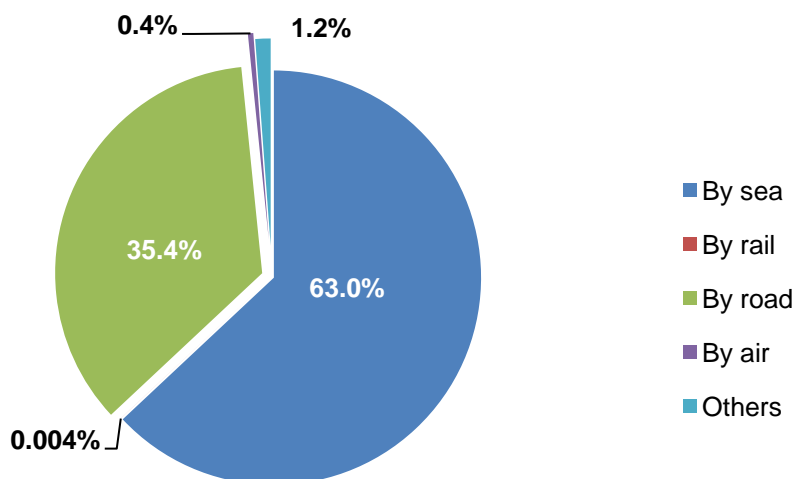
In July 2017, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 79 billion lekë and 53.8 % of them is transported by sea.

Exports of goods

In July 2017, goods eksported by sea represent 63.0 %, by road 35.4 % and by air 0.4 % of total exports of goods.

Goods exported by road, in July 2017, increased by 28.7 % and by sea 1.7 %, compared with July 2016.

In the seventh month of 2017, goods exported by sea represent 63.7 %, by road 34.9 % and by air 0.4 % of total exports of goods. .

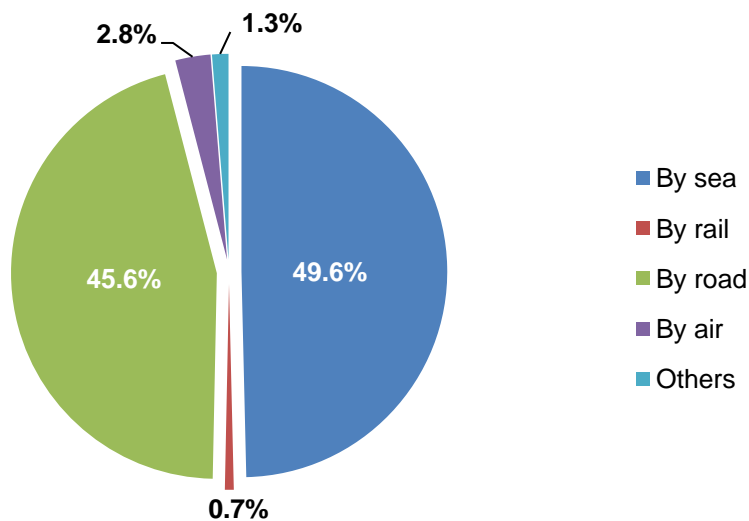
Goods exported by road, in the seventh month of 2017, increased by 25.9 % and by sea increased by 9.4 %, compared with the same period of 2016.

Imports of goods

In July 2017, goods imported by sea represent 49.6 %, by road 45.6 % and by air 2.8 %.

Goods imported by rail, in July 2017, decreased by 15.5 % and by sea increased by 3.4 %, compared with July 2016.

Fig. 2 Structure of imports by mode of transport, July 2017



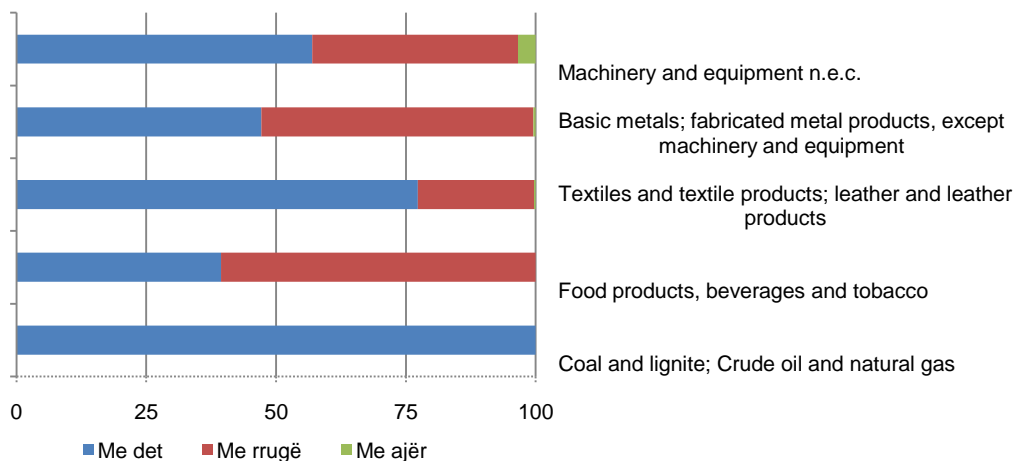
In the seventh month of 2017, goods imported by sea represent 50.3 %, by road 44.1 % and by air 2.9 %.

Goods imported by rail, in seventh month of 2017, increased by 53.4 % and by road decreased by -4.6 %, compared with the same period of 2016.

Main goods exported, by mode of transport

Five main group of goods exported, by Standard Goods Classification for Transport Statistics (NST 2007), represent 79.1 %, of the total value of goods exported in July 2017.

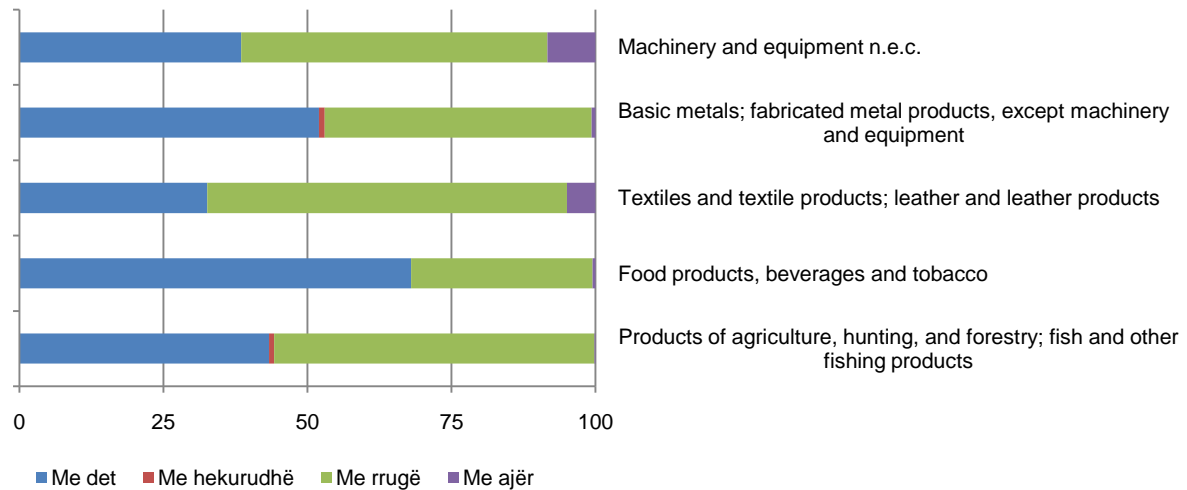
Fig. 3 Five main group of goods exported, by mode of transport

Methodology

Definitions

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport July be carried out by land, air and sea means.

Rail transport: Every movement of freights and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Standard Goods Classification for Transport Statistics (NST2007) is a goods nomenclature used mainly for transports statistics
