

# Transport statistics

## June, 2018

Tirana, 27 July 2018: The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in June 2018 is 277 thousand/tonnes decreasing 14.9 % compared to June 2017.

In the first six months 2018, the volume of freight loading/unloading in ports is 1,940 thousand/tonnes, decreasing by 0.4 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

The volume of freight transported by rail is 1,584 thousand tonnes–kilometer decreasing by 34.8 % compared to June 2017.

In the first six months 2018, volume of freights transported by rail is 8,300 thousand tonnes-km, decreased by 33.4 % compared with the same period of 2017.

In June 2018 ,the volume of freights transported by air is 175 tonnes.

In the first six months 2018, the volume of freightst transported by is 1075 tonnes, decreasing by 2.4 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

In June 2018, number of flights is 2,314 marking an increasing by 13.1 %, compared to June 2017.

The number of passengers traveling by sea line in June 2018 is 133,037 passengers, compared to June 2017, this indicator increasing by 10.0 %.

In the first six months of 2018, 445,588 passengers traveled by sea, decreased 4.5 % compared to the same period a previous year .

In the first six months 2018, passenger air transport occupies 72.7 % of the total transport. The number of passengers traveling by line i n the first six months of 2018 is 1.270,329 persons, increasing by 13.4 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

### Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

In June 2018, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 81 billion lekë and 53.6 % of them is transported by sea.

In the first six months of 2018, vlera the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 467 billion lekë and 54.4 % of them is transported by sea.

### Exports of goods

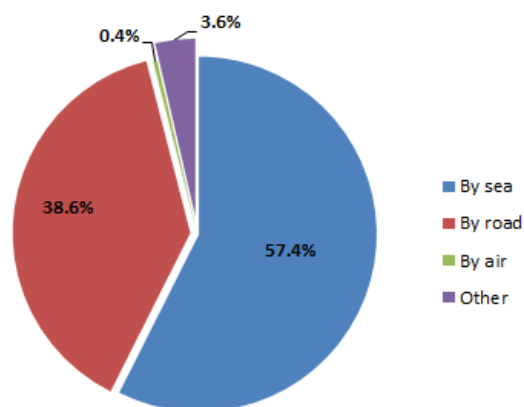
In June 2018, goods exported by sea represent 57.4 %, by road 38.6 % and by air 0.4 % of total exports of goods.

Goods exported by road, in June 2018, increased by 23.7 % while by air decreasing 36.0 %, compared with June 2017.

In the first six months of 2018, goods exported by sea represent 58.8 %, by road 34.6 % and by air 0.4 %.

Goods exported by road, in the first six months of 2018, increased by 17.8 % and by rail decreased by 15.0 %, compared with a same period of previous year.

### Imports of goods

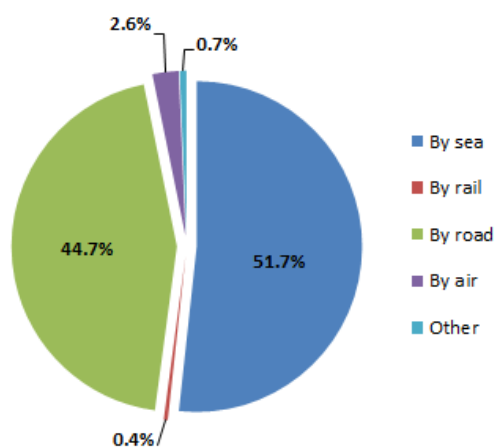
In June 2018, goods imported by sea represent 51.7 %, by road 44.7 % and by air 2.6 %.

Goods imported by rail decreased by 57.3 % and by sea decreased by 3.1 %, compared with June 2017.

In the first six months of 2018, goods imported by sea represent 52.2 %, by road 42.9 % and by air 2.8 %.

Goods imported by road, in the first six months of 2018, increased by 2.5 % while by rail decreased by 26.2 %, compared with a same period of previous year.

# Methodology

## Definitions

**Airlines** include companies that transporting passengers and goods.

**Transport:** Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport July be carried out by land, air and sea means.

**Rail transport: Every** movement of freights and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

**Maritime transport:** Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

**Air transport:** Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

**Exports** are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

**The FOB (free on board)** value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

**Imports** are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

**The cost, insurance and freight (CIF)** price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

**Standard Goods Classification for Transport Statistics (NST2007)** is a goods nomenclature used mainly for transports statistics
