


Foreign Trade in Goods

September 2022

Tirana, October 17, 2022: On September 2022 the value of exports was ALL 39 billion, increasing by 16.3 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 9.5 % compared with August 2022. The value of imports was ALL 88 billion, increasing by 27.4 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 10.5 % compared with August 2022. This month the trade deficit is ALL 49 billion, increasing by 37.6 % compared with September 2021 and by 11.3 % compared with August 2022.

Fig.1 Annual change in Foring Trade (%)




In the first nine months of 2022, the value of exports was ALL 366 billion, increasing by 37.9 %, compared with previous year and the value of imports was ALL 695 billion, increasing by 25.1 % compared with previous year. Trade deficit was ALL 329 billion, increasing by 13.4 % compared with the same period of 2021.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual increase of exports by 16.3 % this month, a positive contribution was given by the groups: "Textile and footwear" with +5.8 percentage point, "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with +5.2 percentage point, and "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +3.0 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Construction materials and metals" with -1.3 percentage point and "Leather and leather manufacturing" with -0.01 percentage point.

Fig.2 Contribution of groups in annual change of exports September 2022




Exports during the first nine months of 2022 are increased by 37.9 % compared with the same period of previous year. The main groups that influenced more in annual increase of exports are: "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with +11.1 percentage point, "Construction materials and metals" with +10.9 percentage point, and "Textile and footware" with +6.6 percentage point.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In annual increase of imports by 27.4 %, this month has mainly affected the groups: "Construction materials and metals" with +8.8 percentage point, "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with +5.7 percentage point, and "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +5.2 percentage point.





In the first nine months of 2022, imports are increased by 25.1 % compared with the same period of previous year. The groups affected positivity in annual increase of imports, are: "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with +10.9 percentage point, "Construction materials and metals" with +4.8 percentage point and "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +3.5 percentage point.

The performance of trade in goods by partner countries


In September 2022, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to September 2021 are: Italy (16.8 %), Germany (110.5 %) and Macedonia (30.5 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Kosovo (24.8 %), Spain (1.6 %) and Greece (26.5 %).

In the first nine months of 2022, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to the same period of 2021 are: Italy (45.0 %), Kosovo (1.8 %) and Germany (79.2 %) . While, country with which has had a decrease of imports is: Spain (15.4 %) .

In September 2022, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to September 2021 are: Italy (7.5 %), Turkey (102.4 %) and Greece (32.4 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Kosovo (21.6 %), Russia (28.7 %) and USA (29.3 %).

In the first nine months or 2022, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to the same period of 2021 are: Italy (10.4 %), Turkey (41.8 %) and Greece (33.6 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: USA (17.4 %), Russia (19.6 %) and Switzerland (27.7 %) .

Trade with the EU countries is 58.4 % of total trade. In September 2022, exports to EU countries occuped 77.0 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 50.3 % of total import. The main trade partners remain: Italy (26.4 %), Turkey (10.7 %), Germany (8.3 %), and Greece (7.8 %).

Trade with the EU countries, in the first nine months of 2022 is 59.5 % of total trade. In this period, the share of exports to EU countries was 73.6 % of total export and share of imports from EU countries was 52.1 % of total import. The main trade partners are: Italy (29.4 %), Turkey (8.4 %), Greece (7.2 %) and Germany (6.6 %).

Methodology

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing

arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs

frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed. or are left in warehouse, under

customs procedure of release for free circulation. inward processing or processing under customs

control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing

country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other

taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics

and for customs tariffs.

Member State of European Union: Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands,

Denmark, Ireland, Greece, Spain, Portugal, Austria, Finland, Sweden, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia,

Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia.
