

Transport statistics*

November 2022

Tirana, 22 December 2022: In November 2022, the Transport statistics by types are presented as follows:

The volume of freights transported by air is 205.2 tonnes, increasing by 7.7 % compared to November 2021.

The volume of freights loading/unloading in ports is 269.8 thousand / tonnes, decreasing by 28.0 % compared to November 2021.

The volume of freights transported by rail is 1,801 thousand / tonnes – km, increasing by 30.2 % compared to November 2021.

In eleven months of 2022, the Transport statistics by types are as follows:

Volume of freights transported by air is 1,888.1 tonnes, increasing by 2.8 % compared to the same period of 2021.

Volume of freights loading/unloading in ports is 3,531.3 thousand / tonnes, decreasing by 20.9 % compared to the same period of 2021.

In November 2022, the indicators on the number of flights and the number of passengers are presented as follows:

The number of flights is 2,826 increased by 33.1 % compared to November 2021.

The number of passengers traveling by air is 390,748 passengers, increased by 70.0 %, compared to November 2021.

The number of passengers traveling by sea line is 43,519 passengers. Compared to November 2021, this indicator increased 28.4 %.

The number of passengers traveling by rail is 165 passengers. Compared to November 2021, this indicator decreased by 84.0 %.

In November 2022, passenger air transport occupies 89.9 % of the total transport.

In eleven months of 2022, the indicators on the number of passengers are presented as follows:

The number of passengers traveling by air line is 4,830,165 passengers, increasing by 81.8 %, compared to the same period of 2021.

The number of passengers traveling by sea is 1,291,771 passengers, increased by 60.7 % compared to the same period of 2021.

The number of passengers traveling by rail is 10,481 passengers, decreasing by 54.9 %, compared to the same period of 2021.

Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

In November 2022, the volume of goods traded (exports and imports) is 773.4 thousand / tonnes, where 55.4 % of them is transported by sea.

In the nine months of 2022, the volume of goods traded (exports and imports) is 8,257.4 thousand / tonnes, where 54.9 % of them is transported by sea.

Exports of goods

In November 2022, the volume of goods exported by land represent 54.1~%, by sea 45.8~% and 0.1~% exported by air.

The volume of goods exported by sea increased 19.1 %, while the volume of goods exported by land decreased by 17.8 % and by air decreased by 50.4 % compared to the same period of 2021.



In the eleven months of 2022, the volume of goods exported by land represents 55.5 %, by sea 44.4 % and by rail 0.1 %.

The volume of goods exported by rail increased by 89.8 %, by air increased by 8.6 % and the volume of goods exported by sea increased by 1.2 %, while the volume of goods exported by land decreased by 17.4 % compared to the same period of 2021.

Imports of goods

In November 2022, the volume of goods imported by sea represents 64.2 %, by land 34.8 % and the other 1.0 %. The volume of goods imported by air increased by 29.6 %, while the volume of goods imported by sea decreased by 11.1 % and by land decreased by 18.1 %, compared to November 2021.



In the eleven months of 2022, the volume of goods imported by sea represented 63.0 %, by land 36.2 %, by rail 0.1 % and the other 0.7 %. The volume of goods imported by rail decreased by 91.0 %, by air decreased by 15.7 %, by land by 9.6 % and by sea decreased by 3.9 %, compared to the same period of 2021.

Methodology

The Transport Statistics publication presents the results on the transport of goods and passengers by type, as well as the export and import of goods by mode of transport, on a monthly basis, The data are administrative, The main source of information is the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy and General Directorate of Customs,

Definitions

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport, Transport is carried out by rail, land, sea and air.

Rail transport: Every movement of freights and /or passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

Land transport: Any movement of goods using a road vehicle on a given road network.

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Exports: Goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

Imports: Goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control. **Nomenclature of Transport Statistics (NST 2007)**: A statistical nomenclature for the goods transported by four modes of transport: road, rail, inland waterways and sea (maritime).

The data of maritime, rail and air transport are preliminary and subject to revision. For more refer: Statistical revision policy,
