


Foreign Trade in Goods

May 2023

Tirana, June 19, 2023: On May 2023 the value of exports was ALL 40 billion, decreasing by -11.7 % compared with the same period of previous year and increasing by 16.8 % compared with April 2023. The value of imports was ALL 81 billion, increasing by 1.2 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 7.7 % compared with April 2023. This month the trade deficit is ALL 41 billion, increasing by 17.8 % compared with May 2022 and by 0.2 % compared with April 2023.






In the first five months of 2023, the value of exports was ALL 196 billion, decreasing by -5.2 %, compared with previous year and the value of imports was ALL 364 billion, decreasing by -0.3 % compared with previous year. Trade deficit was ALL 167 billion, decreasing by 6.1 % compared with the same period of 2022.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual decrease of exports by -11.7 % this month, a contribution was given by the groups: "Constructions materials and metals" with -10.4 percentage point, "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with -7.1 percentage point and "Wood manufactories and article of paper" with -0.6 percentage point. While a positive contribution was given by the group: "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +2.9 percentage point, and "Textile and footwear" with +1.0 percentage point.

Fig.2 Contribution of groups in annual change of exports May 2023




Exports during the five months of 2023 are decreased by -5.2 % compared with the same period of previous year. The main groups that influenced more in annual decrease of exports are: "Constructions materials and metals" with -6.1 percentage point, "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -1.7 percentage point, and "Wood manufactories and article of paper" with -0.3 percentage point. While a positive contribution was given by the group: "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +1.5 percentage point and "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +1.0 percentage point.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In annual increase of imports by +1.2 %, this month has mainly affected the group: Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +4.8 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -1.2 percentage point, Textile and footwear" with -0.8 percentage point and "Food, beverages, tobacco" with -0.5 percentage point.

In the first five months of 2023, imports are decreased by 0.3 % compared with the same period of previous year. The groups affected negativity in annual increase of imports, are: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -3.7 percentage point and "Constructions materials and metals" with -0.9 percentage point and "Food, beverages, tobacco" with -0.5 percentage point. While a positive contribution was given by the groups: "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +4.4 percentage point, "Chemical and plastical products" with +0.8 percentage point.

The performance of trade in goods by partner countries


In May 2023, countries with has the highest decrease of exports, compared to May 2022 are: Italy (11.7 %), Germany (31.2 %) and North Macedonia (19.0 %). While, countries with the highest increase of exports are: Kosovo (23.6 %), Greece (2.8 %), and Spain (331.5 %).

In the first five months of 2023, countries with has the highest decrease of exports, compared to the same period of 2022 are: Italy (10.9 %), Germany (29.2 %) and China (45.9 %). While, countries which has the highest increase of exports are: Greece (40.3 %), Kosovo (7.2 %) and North Macedonia (22.4 %).

In May 2023, countries with which Albania has the highest increase of imports, compared to May 2022 are: China (55.3 %), Greece (3.6 %) and Germany (8.1 %). While, countries with the highest decrease of imports are: Italy 4.8 %), Turkey (17,6 %) and North Macedonia (26.1 %).

In the first five months or 2023, countries with the highest decrease of imports, compared to the same period of 2022 are: Italy (3.2 %), Turkey (20.4 %) and Greece (13.6 %). While, countries with the highest increase of imports are: China (37.3 %), Germany (8.1 %) and USA (49.0 %).

Trade with the EU countries is 58.6 % of total trade. In May 2023, exports to EU countries occuped 73.0 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 51.5 % of total import. The main trade partners remain: Italy (31.3 %), China (8.3 %), Greece (6.6 %), and Germany (6.1 %).

Trade with the EU countries, in the first five months of 2023 is 59.3 % of total trade. In this period, the share of exports to EU countries was 73.8 % of total export and share of imports from EU countries was 51.5 % of total import. The main trade partners are: Italy (30.4 %), China (7.3 %), Turkey (7.0 %) and Greece (6.8 %).

Methodology

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse. under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics and for customs tariffs.

Member State of European Union: Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Denmark, Ireland, Greece, Spain, Portugal, Austria, Finland, Sweden, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia.
