Road Transport Statistics

Second Quarter, 2023

Tirana, 28 July 2023: The length of the road network in use during the second quarter of 2023, is 3,606 km referring to different categories, such as motorway, interurban or urban and local roads. Secondary interurban roads occupy about 74.2 % of the length of the road network.

The total number of road vehicles, for the second quarter of 2023, with the status of "active" and "temporarily deregistered", in the territory of the Republic of Albania until June is 828,306 vehicles.

In the category of road vehicles by type, the largest percentage of the total number of road vehicles is occupied by "Passenger cars" (80.4 %), " Mixed transport vehicles " (6.4 %) and " Motor vehicles" (5.5 %).

The highest number of road vehicles in the second quarter of 2023, are registered in prefecture of Tirana, accounting 34.8 % of the total road vehicles registered in country, followed by the district of Durrës by 13.4 % of the total road vehicles.

The prefectures with the lowest number of road vehicles are Gjirokastër by 2.2 % and prefectures Kukës by 2.3 % to the total road vehicles.

During the second quarter of 2023, 19,794 road vehicles were registered for the first time and until the end of June, 34,253 road vehicles were registered for the first time, of which there are 30 types of vehicles and 434 brands.

In the category of road vehicles according to the type registered for the first time, the largest percentage of the total number of road vehicles is occupied by "Cars" (83.9%) and "Motorcycles" (7.4%).

The highest number of road vehicles registered for the first time is in the district of Tirana, accounting for 42.7% of the total road vehicles registered in the country in the second quarter of 2023.

The counties with the smallest number of road vehicles registered for the first time are Gjirokastër county with 1.2% and Kukës with 2.0% each of the total road vehicles.

Methodology

The Transport Statistics publication presents the results on the transport of goods and passengers by type, as well as the export and import of goods by mode of transport, on a monthly basis. The data are administrative. The main source of information is the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy and General Directorate of Customs.

Definitions

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport is carried out by rail, land, sea and air.

Road transport: Any movement of goods using a road vehicle on a defined road network.

Passenger Car - motor vehicle of road transport intended for passenger transport, in which the number of seats (including the driver) does not exceed the number 9.

Bus - motor vehicle of road transport intended for passenger transport with the number of seats (including driver's seat) with more than 9 seats.

Lorry/Truck: Rigid road motor vehicle designed, exclusively or primarily, to carry goods.

Motorcycle- A motor vehicle, with two, three or four wheels not exceeding 400 kg of unloaded weight.

Trailer: Goods road vehicle designed to be hauled by a road motor vehicle.

Mixed transport vehicles (ATP) - includes vehicles that have a total full load weight not exceeding 3.5 tons, or 4.5 tones when there is battery traction; are intended for the transport of people and goods with a maximum capacity of nine seats, including the driver's seat.

Special transport vehicles (ATV) - means of transport intended for the transport of certain goods or people under special conditions and is characterized by the equipment jointly, with special mechanisms that serve this purpose.

Special purpose vehicles (APV) - vehicles permanently equipped with special mechanisms and generally intended for the transport of these mechanisms; on these vehicles is allowed the transport of personnel and materials related to the operational cycle of these mechanisms, as well as the transport of people and goods related to the destination of use of these mechanisms.

Exports: Goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

Imports: Goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control. **Nomenclature of Transport Statistics (NST 2007)**: A statistical nomenclature for the goods transported by four modes of transport: road, rail, inland waterways and sea (maritime).

The data of maritime, rail and air transport are preliminary and subject to revision. For more refer: Statistical revision policy,
