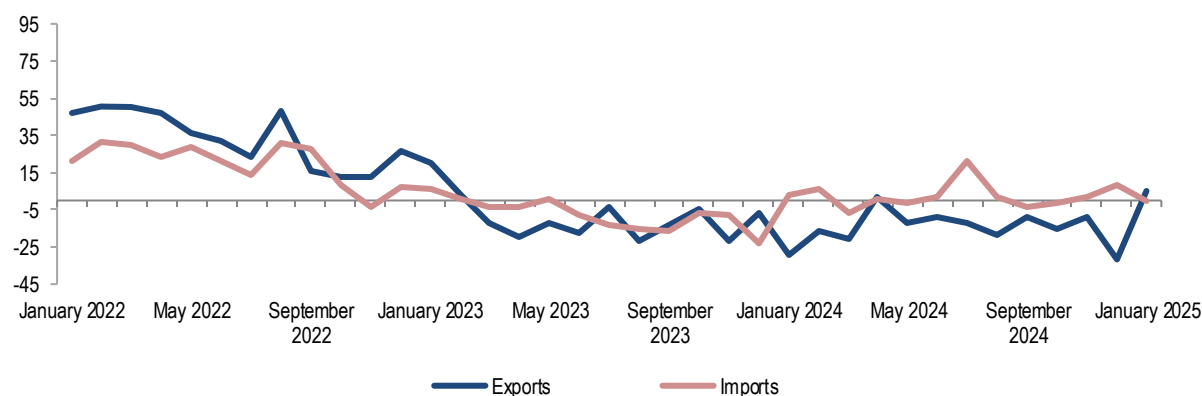


# Foreign Trade in Goods

## January 2025

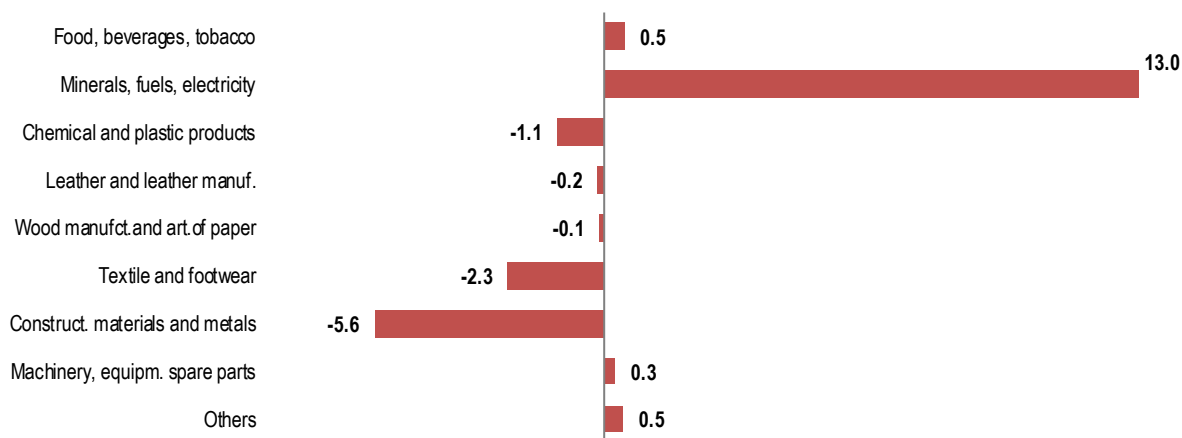
**Tirana, February 17, 2025:** On January 2025 the value of exports was ALL 31 billion, increasing by 4.9 %, compared with the same period of previous year and increasing by 21.7 %, compared with December 2024. The value of imports was ALL 60 billion, increasing by 0.1 %, compared with the previous year and decreased by 23.5 %, compared with December 2024. This month the trade deficit is ALL 29 billion, decreasing by 4.5 %, compared with January 2024 and decreasing by 45.4 %, compared with December 2024.

**Fig. 1 Annual change in Foreign Trade(%)**

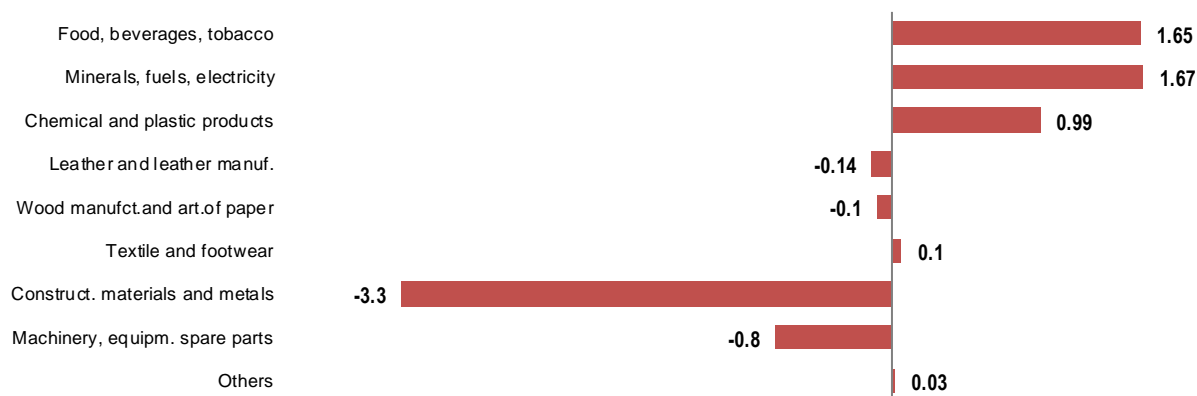


### The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual increase of exports by 4.9 % this month, a contribution was given by the groups: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with +13.0 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +0.5 percentage point, : "Machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +0.3 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Constructions materials and metals" with -5.6 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -2.3 percentage point, "Chemical and plastic products" with -1.1 percentage point, etc.

In January 2025 the increasing of imports by +0.1 %, compared with the same month of the previous year, was positively affected by the groups: “Minerals, fuels, electricity” with +1.67 percentage point, “Food, beverages, tobacco” with +1.65 percentage point, “Chemical and plastic products” with +0.99 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the groups: “Constructions materials and metals” with -3.3 percentage point, “Machinery, equipment and spare parts” with -0.8 percentage point, “Leather and leather manuf.” with -0.14 percentage point.

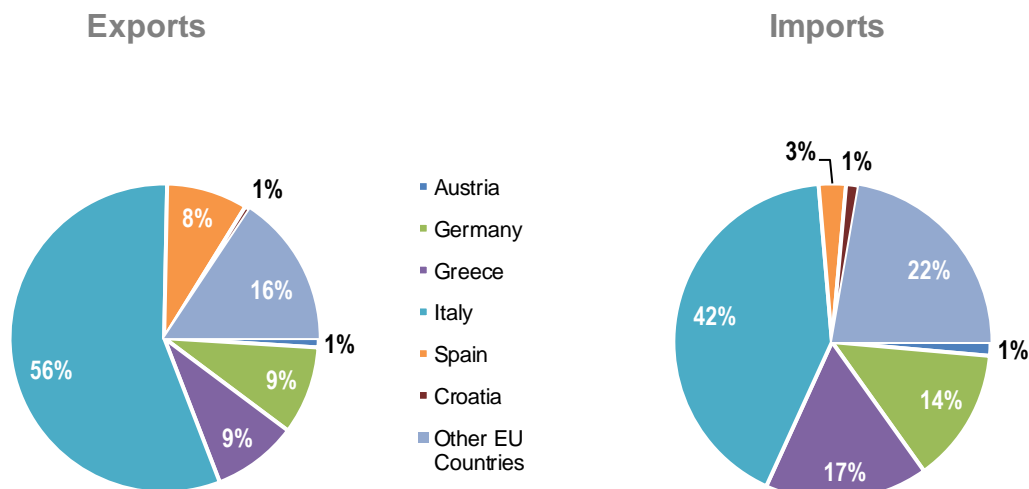
**Fig.3 Contribution of groups in annual change of imports, January 2025**

### The performance of trade in goods by partner countries

In January 2025, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to January 2024 are: Kosovo (91.6 %), Greece (2.0 %), Spain (86.0 %), etj. While, countries with which has had a decrease of exports are: Italy (17.7 %), Germany (1.6 %), Turkiye (43.1 %).

In January 2025, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to January 2024 are: Italy (5.9 %), China (45.4 %), Greece (2.1 %), etc. While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are Turkiye (9.1 %), Germany (2.0 %), USA (55.5 %), etc.

Trade with the EU countries is 56.9 % of total trade. In January 2025, exports to EU countries occupied 68.2 % of total exports and imports from EU countries occupied 51.1 % of total imports.

The main trade partners remain: Italy (27.2 %), China (9.9 %), Greece (7.7 %), Kosovo (7.0 %).

# Methodology

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics and for customs tariffs.
