


Foreign Trade in Goods

May 2017

Tirana, June 19, 2017: On May 2017 the value of exports was 24 billion lekë, increasing by 18.0 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 0.8 % compared with April 2017. The value of imports in May 2017, was 55 billion lekë, increasing by 5.8 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 9.7 % compared with April 2017. This month the trade deficit is 31 billion lekë signing an decrease by 2.2 % compared with May 2016 and increasing by 18.0 % compared with April 2017.

In the first five months of 2017, the value of exports was 111 billion lekë, increasing by 16.7 %, compared with previous year and the value of imports was 238 billion lekë, increasing by 4.6 %. Trade deficit was 127 billion lekë, decreasing by 4.1 % compared with the same period of 2016.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual increase of exports by 18.0 % this month a positive contribution was given by the groups: "construction materials and metals" with +7.0 percentage point, "food, beverage, tobacco" with +4.2 percentage point, "textile and footwear" with +3.7 percentage point.





Fig.2 Annual impact of groups in exports

In the first five months of 2017, exports are increased by 16.7 % compared with previous year. A positive contribution was given by the groups: "construction materials and metals" with +5.5 percentage point, "minerals, fuels, electricity" with +5.1 percentage point, "textile and footwear" with +3.5 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the group: "wood manufacture and article of paper" with -0.1 percentage point.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In annual increase of imports by 5.8 % in May 2017 a positive contribution was given by the groups: "textile and footwear" with +1.8 percentage point, "food, beverage, tobacco" with +1.4 percentage point, "chemical and plastical products" with +1.2 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the group: "construction materials and metals" with -1.3 percentage point.





In the first five months of 2017, imports are increased by 4.6 % compared with previous year. A positive contribution was given by the groups: "chemical and plastical products" with +1.6 percentage point, "textile and footwear" with +1.2 percentage point, "machinery, equipment and spare parts" with +1.0 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the group: "construction materials and metals" with -1.5 percentage point.

The performance of trade in goods by partner countries


In May 2017, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to May 2016 are: Italy with (9.7 %), Kosovo with (31.6 %) and Spain with (247.9 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of exports are: Greece with (-4.0 %), China with (-28.5 %) and Bulgaria with (-9.7 %).

In the first five months of 2017, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to the same period of 2016 are: Italy with (9.6 %), Kosovo with (24.8 %) and Spain with (158.6 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of exports are: Switzerland with (-39.1 %), Croatia with (-45.8 %) and Denmark with (-31.4 %).

In May 2017, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to May 2016 are: Italy with (7.3 %), Turkey with (41.4 %) and Greece with (16.2 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: China with (-9.3 %), Germany with (-36.3 %) and Spain with (-21.3 %).

In the first five months of 2017, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to the same period of 2016 are: Italy with (3.8 %), Turkey with (16.0 %) and Greece with (7.5 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of exports are: Germany with (-13.1 %), China with (-9.6 %) and Russia with (-21.1 %).

Trade with the EU countries is 66.4 % of total trade. In May 2017, exports to EU countries occuped 76.1 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 62.2 % of total import. The main trade partners remain Italy (37.7 %), Greece (6.8 %) Turkey (6.7 %) and China (6.3 %).

Trade with the EU countries, in the first five months of 2017 is 65.7 % of total trade. In the first five months of 2017, exports to EU countries occuped 76.5 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 60.7 % of total import. The main trade partners are: Italy (37.6 %), Germany (7.0 %), Greece (6.8 %) and China (6.4 %).

DEFINITIONS

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics and for customs tariffs.
