The number of passengers traveling with maritime lines is 43,176 persons, compared with February 2016, this indicator decreased by 5.7%.




Fig. 1 Passenger transport by mode of travel

Definitions

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport may be carried out by land, air and sea means.

Rail transport: Every movement of freigts and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Sorce data: The data are provided by the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure
