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Preliminary results on structural survey of enterprises, 2016

Tirana, November 23, 2017: In 2016, refers to the preliminary results of structural survey of economic enterprises, turnover for producers of goods and services reached 1,882 billion ALL, increased by 4.4 % compared with 2015. Investments reached 221 billion ALL from 208 billion ALL in 2015, marking an increase of 6.3 %. In this period, the total number of employed increased by 7.9 %. In the goods and services producers operate 108,528 active enterprises. The number of enterprises increased by 3.8 % compared with 2015.

Comments on main indicators

Based on the Final results of the Structural Business Survey, the largest contribution to the **turnover** growth rate by 4.4 %, was provided by producers of services with +3.7 p.p. followed by producers of goods with +0.7 p.p. During 2016, the trade sector marked the highest percentage of turnover, 48.1 %, followed by the construction sector with 11.5 %. The sectors with the lowest percentage of turnover were the accommodation and restaurants sector (2.3 %) and the mining and guarrying sector (3.4 %).

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The same situation is presented for the **employment** indicator. Employment increased by 7.9 %, where producers of services had the largest contribution on the increase, by +4.7 p.p, while producers of goods contributed +3.2 p.p. The two sectors with the highest percentage of number of employed, in 2016, were trade sector with 24.3 % of employed and other services sector (private health and education, administrative services, professional, scientific and technical services, etc.) with 21.7 %, followed by manufacturing sector with 20.3 % of the total employed.

During 2016, **investments** marked an increase of 6.3 %, where contribution of goods producers was +14.4 p.p, while producers of services contributed negatively by 8.1 p.p. The producers of services constituted 28.3 % of investments compared with 38.2 %, in the previous year. The sector with the highest value of investments realized was electricity and water sector, which invested 94 billion ALL and constituted 42.4 % of total investments during 2016. The sectors with the lowest value of investments realized were the accommodation and restaurants sector (2.2 %) and the mining and quarrying sector (2.8 %).

The number of **active enterprises** increased with 3.8 % during 2016. The producers of services contributed by +3.2 p.p while the producers of goods by +0.6 p.p. The sector with the largest number of active enterprises was trade sector (41.5 %), followed by other services sector (20.0 %) and accommodation and restaurant sector (18.5 %). During 2016, mining and quarrying sector had the lowest number of active enterprises, which constituted 0.5 % of the total.





Fig.1 Contribution of goods and services producers in the annual growth rate of main indicators, 2016/2015

The turnover growth rate has a positive trend for goods and services producers. The mining and quarrying sector is the only sector that has a decrease on turnover by 22.9 %. This sector had a negative contribution on the total turnover growth (4.4 %), by -1.0 p.p.

Comments by size class of enterprises


During 2016, analyzing of indicators by size class of enterprises showed that enterprises with 50 or more employed constituted 1.1 % of active enterprises, realized 44.5 % of turnover, engaged 40.0 % of the total number of employed and represented 47.3 % of the total investments.

Based on the results of structural survey 2016, enterprises with 1-4 employed have the largest contribution to the total annual growth rate of turnover with +1.7 p.p, followed by enterprises with 50 or more employed, with +1.5 p.p.

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In enterprises with 50 or more employed dominated the producers of goods for the number of enterprises (55.3 %), the number of employed (54.7 %) and investments realized (74.2 %). In this group of enterprises, the highest value of turnover was realized by producers of services with 54.4 %.

Enterprises with 1-4 employed constituted 89.0 % of total enterprises, engaged 32.7% of the total number of employed and realized 15.3 % of turnover. In enterprises with 1-4 employed dominated the producers of services for indicators as: the number of enterprises (89.7 %), the number of employed (87.6 %), turnover (82.7 %). In this group of enterprises, the highest value of investments was realized by producers of goods with 67.5 %.




Fig.4 Main indicators structure by size class of enterprises, 2016

Comments on economic activities and size class of enterprises

In producers of goods, during 2016, all the indicators marked an increase compared to 2015, the number of active enterprises (4.6 %), the number of employed (8.9 %), turnover (2.1 %) and investments (23.3 %).

During 2016, enterprises with 50 and more employed represented 4.6% of the enterprises of goods producers and realized 60.9 % of turnover. The number of employed in this group constituted 61.3 % of employed, while investments reached 78 billion ALL and represented 48.9 % of investments. Enterprises with 1-4 employed represented 71.7 % of enterprises for goods producers and 11.4 % of employed. This group of enterprises realized 7.9 % of turnover and 6.9 % of investments for producers of goods.

In producers of services, during 2016, turnover increased by 5.6 % compared with 2015, the number of employed increased by 7.3% and the number of enterprises increased by 3.7%. While, in 2016, investments for producers of services decreased by 21.1%, compared with 2015.

During 2016, enterprises of services producers with 50 and more employed, constituted 0.5% of enterprises and realized 36.3% of total turnover for producers of services. They invested 27 billion ALL which represent 43.2% of investments of services producer's enterprise. Enterprises with 1-4 employed represent 91.6% of enterprises and engaged 44.6% of employed for services producers. This group invested the lowest amount, about 5 billion ALL, which constitutes 8.4% of investments in services producers.

Methodology

The main aim of structural business statistics is to show the structure of the business sector with regard to economic data. Data are presented for the total business sector by economic activities and by size class of enterprises. Statistics comprise all enterprises that produce goods or services for the market in Albania, for all legal forms (there are not included financial, agricultural and fishing activities). Population consists of all enterprises that according to statistical register were active in December of the reference year. Classification of enterprises is done according to Classification of Economic Activities, NACE Rev.2. Data are collected for calendar year. The fiscal year always corresponds to the calendar year. Enterprises are classified on size classes by number of employed (measured as employed on a full-time basis). Enterprises with 1-9 employed are surveyed by sample survey. Enterprises with 10 and more employed are surveyed exhaustively. The data are collected directly from enterprises. Review of data

Preliminary results of structural business statistics are published 11 months after the end of reference year. Final results are published 14 months after the end of reference year. These results are published after reviewing the preliminary data. Reviewing means the continuing process for data accuracy. Accuracy of published data can be increased as a consequence of providing new and more complete and quality data that significantly contribute in improving the preliminary results, published according to predefined deadlines in the publications calendar.

Definitions of basic variables

An enterprise

An enterprise is the smallest combination of legal units that is an organizational unit producing goods or services, which benefits from a certain degree of autonomy in decision - making, especially for the allocation of its current resources. An enterprise carries out one or more activities.

Turnover

Turnover comprises the totals amount invoiced by the observation unit during the reference period, and this corresponds to market sales of goods or services supplied to third parties.

Employed

Employed is defined as the total number of persons who work in the observation unit including proprietors, employees and unpaid family workers.

Investments

Investments during the reference period includes the goods, whether bought from third parties or produced for own use, having a useful life of more than one year including non-produced tangible goods such as land.
