

Transport statistics

January, 2018

Tirana, February 27, 2018: The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in January 2018 is 302 thousand / tonnes increasing 38.4 % compared with January 2017.

In January 2018, the Port of Durres are performed 92.7 %, the volume of freights loaded / unloading at all ports.

The volume of freight transported by rail is 761 thousand tonnes - kilometer, increasing 13.8 % compared to January 2017.

In January 2018, the volume of freights transported by air is 182 tonnes, increasing by 15.9 % compared with the same month of year 2017.

In January 2018, number of flights is 2,052 marking an increase by 13.6 %, compared with the same period of previous year,

In Januar 2018 are concluded 8,758 overflights, marking an increase of 9.0 % compared to 2017.

In January 2018, the number of passengers traveling with airline 214,191, increasing by 11.7 % compared to January 2017.

The number of passengers travelling sea line is 67,295 persons in January 2018 compared to January 2017, this indicator decreased by 11.4 %.

Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

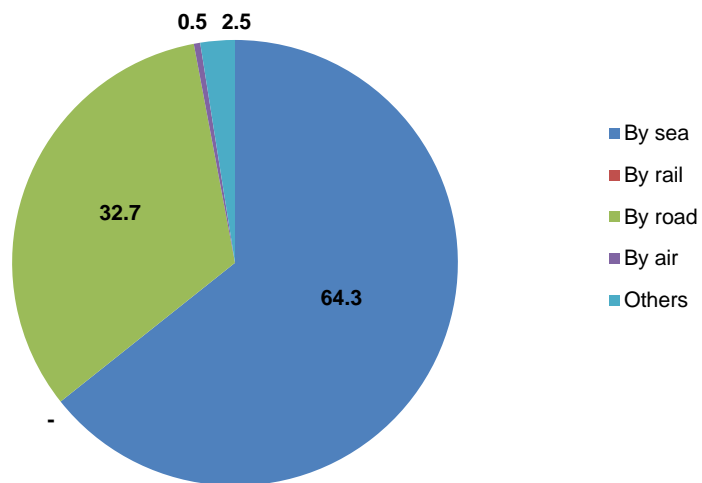
In January 2018, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 68 billion lekë and 54.4 % of them is transported by sea.

Exports of goods

In January 2018, goods exported by sea represent 64.3 %, by road 32.7 % and by air 0.5 % of total exports of goods.

Goods exported by road, January 2018, increased by 48.9 % and by sea 11.9 %, compared with January 2017.

Fig. 1 Structure of exports by mode of transport, January 2018

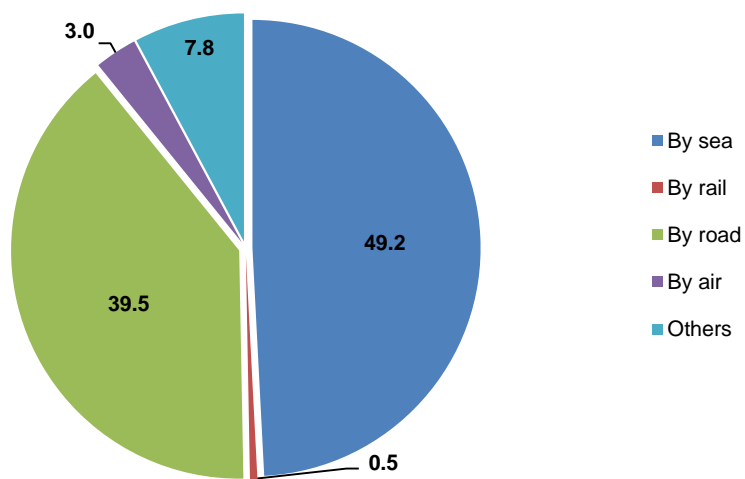


Imports of goods

In January 2018, goods imported by sea represent 49.2 %, by road 39.5 % and by air 3.0 %.

Goods imported by rail, in January 2018, increased by 26.1 % and by road 22.3 %, compared with January 2017.

Methodology

Definitions

Airlines include companies that transporting passengers and goods.

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport July be carried out by land, air and sea means.

Rail transport: Every movement of freights and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Standard Goods Classification for Transport Statistics (NST2007) is a goods nomenclature used mainly for transports statistics
