

Transport statistics

July, 2018

Tirana, 27 August 2018: The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in July 2018 is 323 thousand / tonnes decreasing 13.1 % compared to July 2017.

In seven months 2018, the volume of freight loading/unloading in ports is 2,264 thousand/tonnes, decreasing by 2.4 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

The volume of freight transported by rail is 1,906 thousand tonnes–kilometer increasing by 12.5 % compared to July 2017.

In the first six months 2018, volume of freights transported by rail is 10,206 thousand tonnes-km, decreased by 27.9 % compared with the same period of 2017.

In July 2018, the volume of freights transported by air is 181 tonnes.

In seven months 2018, the volume of freightst transported by is 1,256 tonnes, decreasing by 2.6 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

In July 2018, number of flights is 2,758 marking an increasing by 10.6 %, compared to July 2017.

In seven months 2018, are concluded 14,532 flights, marking an increased by 9,8 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

The number of passengers traveling by sea line in July 2018 is 233.700 passengers, compared to July 2017, this indicator increased by 0.5 %.

In seven months of 2018, 679,288 passengers traveled by sea, decreased 2.8 % compared to the same period a previous year .

In seven months 2018, passenger air transport occupies 69.1 % of the total transport. The number of passengers traveling by line in seven months of 2018 is 1.616,240 persons, increasing by 14.4 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

In July 2018, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 85 billion ALL and 55.1 % of them is transported by sea.

In seven months of 2018, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 552 billion lekë and 54.5 % of them is transported by sea.

Exports of goods

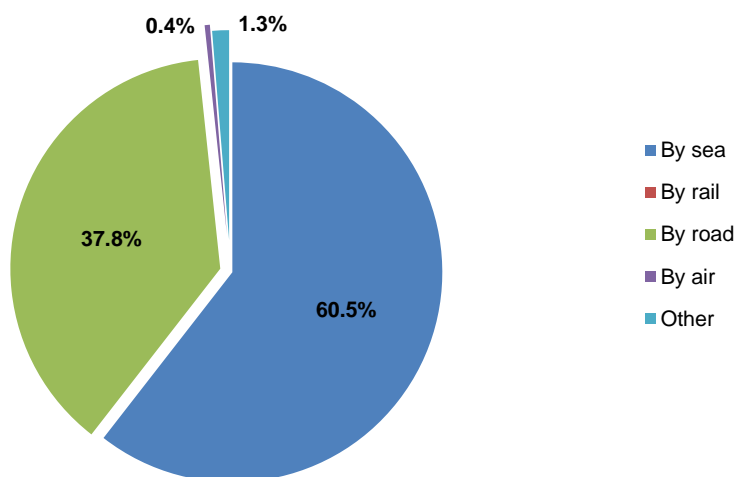
In July 2018, goods exported by sea represent 60.5 %, by road 37.8 % and by air 0.4 % of total exports of goods.

Goods exported by road, in July 2018, increased by 15.4 %.

In seven months of 2018, goods exported by sea represent 59.1 %, by road 35.1 % and by air 0.4 %.

Goods exported by road, in seven months of 2018, increased by 17.5 % and by rail decreased by 22.5 %, compared with a same period of previous year.

Imports of goods

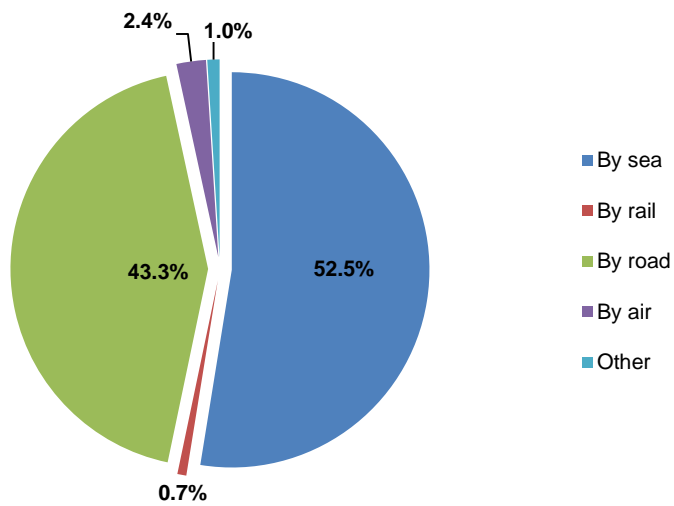
In July 2018, goods imported by sea represent 52.5 %, by road 43.3 % and by air 2.4 %.

Goods imported by rail increased by 11.0 % and by road increased 0.2 %, compared with July 2017.

In seven months of 2018, goods imported by sea represent 52.2 %, by road 42.9 % and by air 2.7 %.

Goods imported by road, in seven months of 2018, increased by 2.2 % while by rail decreased by 20.7 %, compared with a same period of previous year.

Methodology

Definitions

Airlines include companies that transporting passengers and goods.

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport July be carried out by land, air and sea means.

Rail transport: Every movement of freights and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Standard Goods Classification for Transport Statistics (NST2007) is a goods nomenclature used mainly for transports statistics
