

# Wage Statistics


## Quarter 1/2025

**Tirana, on June 11, 2025:** During the first quarter of 2025, the average gross monthly wage per employee in Albania is 82,210 ALL, showing an increase by 11.6 % compared to the first quarter 2024.

### Wages by economic activities and professions

- Economic activities with an average wage higher than the national average:
  - o Financial and insurance activities
  - o Information and communication
- The highest wage increase, compared to the first quarter of 2024:
  - o Public administration, compulsory social security, education, health and social work activities: +16.7%
- The lowest increase, compared to the first quarter of 2024:
  - o Industry: +5.2%
- Professions with an average salary higher than the national average:
  - o Managers, Legislators, Executive Directors
  - o Specialists with higher education (professionals)
- The highest salary increase, compared to the first quarter of 2024:
  - o Armed forces and Specialists with higher education of 23.1% and 13.7% respectively
- The lowest increase, compared to the first quarter of 2024:
  - o Skilled workers agriculture, forestry and fishing: +5.3%


**Fig. 1 Average monthly gross wage per employee, in Albania (ALL) <sup>1</sup>**



<sup>1</sup>Bonuses and additional payments are a part of gross monthly wage per employee, which significantly increase the average gross monthly salary at the end of each semester (see methodological note).

The distribution of employees by average gross monthly wage groups shows a gradual improvement in the wage structure, with a decrease in the number of employees receiving the minimum wage and an increase in the number of employees at higher wages levels.

# Methodology

This publication contains detailed data on the level of wages, their distribution and the change over the quarters. These statistics offer an opportunity to compare salaries in different industries and for different occupational groups, Wage statistics are also of particular importance to the monitoring of economic indicators that are used by policy-makers, employers and trade unions to assess job supply and job requirements.

## Source of Information

The source of Information on wages is the General Directorate of Taxation, based to the memorandum of cooperation. The data are from the enterprise's payroll (E- SIG 025 form).

This form serves to declare three types of tax liabilities:

- Social Security Contributions,
- Health Insurance Contributions
- Income from Employment of Employees,

Variables are three types: original variables from DPT, additional variables from INSTAT and derived variables, the two main variables of interest are the number of employees and the gross wage paid to the employee.

## Definitions

**Average monthly wage** - In the calculation of the average gross monthly wage, are included only the number of contributory employees who work 18 or more days during the reference month. These contributors belong to all economic activities, including the Agriculture, forestry and fishing activity that are declared in the General Directorate of Taxes.

The average gross monthly wage is constituted by the following elements:

- Additional payment for managerial duties
- Additional payment for years at work
- Additional payment for difficult working conditions
- Other regular additional payments

Social security contributions and taxation on income are not deducted from the average monthly wage.

*Median gross monthly wage* - is the average monthly wage in the middle of the wage distribution.

*Real wage* - is the nominal wage adjusted for the level of price changes.

*Monthly minimum wage* - is the official minimum wage approved by a Decision of the Council of Ministers.

*Salary contributors in the sector of Agriculture, Forestry and fishing* - are considered all employees declared in the General Directorate of Taxation, by farms / agricultural enterprises.

## Classifications

- The classification of enterprises is done according to the Nomenclature of Economic Activities, NACE Rev, 2 as follows:
