

Transport statistics

November 2018

Tirana, 27 December 2018: The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in the November 2018 is 317 thousand / tonnes, decreasing 7.2 % compared to November2017.

In eleven months of 2018, the volume of freight loading/unloading in ports is 3,555 thousand/tonnes, decreasing by 4.3 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

The volume of freight transported by rail is 1,628 thousand tonnes–kilometer decreasing by 53.8 % compared to November 2017.

In the eleven months 2018, volume of freights transported by rail is 17,833 thousand tonnes-km, decreased by 25.3 % compared with the same period of 2017.

In the eleven months 2018, the volume of freightst transported by air is 2,014 tonnes, decreasing by 1.6 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

In November 2018, number of flights is 1,780 marking an decreasing by 5.8 %, compared to November 2017.

The number of passengers traveling by sea line in November 2018, is 47.091passengers, compared to in November 2017, this indicator decreased by 9.0 %.

In eleven months 2018, 1,444,936 passengers traveled by sea, increased 0.9 % compared to the same period a previous year .

In November 2018, passenger air tranport occupies zë 79.8 % of the total transport. The number of passengers traveling by line in ten months of 2018 is 2,719,911 persons, increasing by 12.8 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

In November 2018, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 83 billion ALL and 50.7 % of them is transported by sea.

In eleven months of 2018, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 870 billion lekë and 53.9 % of them is transported by sea.

Exports of goods


In November2018, goods exported by sea represent 59.7 %, by road 39.6 % and by air 0.3 % of total exports of goods.

Goods exported by road, in Novembre 2018, increased by 16.3 %, and sea 2.6 % compared with a same period of previous year.

In eleven months of 2018, goods exported by sea represent 58.9 %, by road 36.4 % and by air 0.5 %.

Goods exported by road, in eleven months of 2018, increased by 16.6 % compared with a same period of previous year.

Imports of goods


In November2018, goods imported by sea represent 46.3 %, by road 44.29% and by air 2.9 %.

Goods imported by rail in November 2018 decreased by 61.2% and road by 1.8 %compared to November 2017.

In eleven months of 2018, goods imported by sea represent 51.0 %, by road 43.7 % and by air 2.8 %.

Goods imported by rail, in the eleven months of 2018, decreased by 24.2% and by road they were by 7.2% compared to the same period of the previous year.

Methodology

Definitions

Airlines include companies that transporting passengers and goods.

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport July be carried out by land, air and sea means.

Rail transport: Every movement of freights and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Standard Goods Classification for Transport Statistics (NST2007) is a goods nomenclature used mainly for transports statistics
