




Road accidents

April 2019

Tirana, më 21 May 2019: In April 2019, are counted 112 road accidents, from 134 accidents occurred in April 2018, decreasing by 16.4 % compared to the same period of the previous year.

In April 2019, the number of casualties (killed and injured) is 147 from 168 persons in April 2018, decreasing 12.5 %. In the first four months of 2019, the number of casualties is 630 from 651 persons decreasing by 3.2% compared to the same period of the previous year.

In April 2019, the number of killed from road accidents is 14 persons remaining unchanged compared with April 2018. In the first four months of 2019, the killed from road accidents are 62 from 61 that were in the same period of the previous year.

In April 2019, road accidents, in 84.8 % of cases, occurred as a result of the driver's behavior. The highest number of accidents in this month was carried out by the age group 25-35, accounting for 33.9 % of the total number of accidents. Accidents in this age group have decreased by 17.4 % compared to the same period of the previous year.

In the first four months of 2019,16.0 % of cases, occurred as a result of pedestrian behavior. During this period, the number of accidents by the pedestrian behavior has decreased 25.0 % compared with the same of the previous year.

Definitions

Accidents: Road accidents occurring to one or more persons who are hit by vehicles.

Person killed: It is considered any person killed immediately or dying within 30 days as a result of the accident.

Person injured: It is considered any person not killed but who sustained an injury as a result of an injury accident. normally needing medical treatment.

The behavior of the driver: It means if the driver does not comply with the traffic rules according to the "Road Code" as sudden braking, ignores signs (signaling) traffic, disregard the speed limit, etc.

Pedestrian Behavior: It means if pedestrain does not comply with the traffic rules according to the "Road Code" as crossing the road carelessly, etc.

Source of data: The data are provided by Ministry of Internal Affairs/State police directorate.
