



Transport statistics

August 2019

Tirana, 26 September 2019: The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in the August 2019 is 380 thousand / tonnes, increasing 20.9 % compared to August 2018.

In the eight months of 2019, the volume of freight loading/unloading in ports is 3.0 million/tonnes, increasing by 17.1 % compared to the same period of year 2018.

The volume of freight transported by rail is 2.1 million tonnes-km, increasing by 8.1 % compared to August 2018.

In the eight months of 2019, volume of freights transported by rail is 13.6 million tonnes-km, increased by 12.0 % compared with the same period of 2018.

In August 2019, the volume of freights transported by air is 176 tonnes, increasing by 6.4 % compared to August 2018.

In the eight months of 2019, the volume of freights transported by air is 1,524 tonnes, increasing by 7.3 % compared to the same period of year 2018.

The number of flights, in August 2019, is 3,160, marking an increasing of 9.7 %, compared in August 2018.

The number of passengers traveling by sea line in August 2019, is 446,269 passengers, compared to in August 2018, this indicator decreased by 0.2 %. In the eight months of 2019, 1,162,066 passengers travelled by sea, increased 3.2 % compared to the same period a previous year.

In August 2019, passenger air transport occupies 48.1 % of the total transport. The number of passengers traveling by air line, in the eight months of 2019, is 2,222,029 passengers, increasing by 11.5 % compared to the same period of year 2018.

Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

In August 2019, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 71.6 billion ALL and 49.2 % of them is transported by sea.

In the eight months of 2019, value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 629 billion ALL and 52.0 % of them is transported by sea.

Exports of goods


In August 2019, goods exported by sea represent 55.8 %, by road 40.6 % and by air 2.2 % of total exports of goods.

Goods exported by road increased by 3.7 % compared with a same period of previous year.

In the eight months of 2019, goods exported by sea represent 58.8 %, by road 39.3 % and by air 0.5 %.

In the eight months of 2019, goods exported by road increased by 7.3% compared to the same period of 2018.

Imports of goods


In August 2019, goods imported by sea represent 46.6 %, by road 46.5 % and by air 2.7 %.

Goods imported by road in August 2019 increased by 4.1 % compared to August 2018.

In the eight months of 2019, goods imported by sea represented 48.9%, by road 43.2 % and by air 3.1 %.

In the eight months of 2019, goods imported by road increased by 2.8 % compared with previous year.

Methodology

The Publication of Transport Statistics presents the results on the transport of goods and passengers by type, as well as the export and import of goods by mode of transport, on a monthly basis. The data are administrative. The main source of information is the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy and General Directorate of Customs.

Definitions

Airlines include companies that transporting passengers and goods.

Transport: Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport August is carried out by land, air and sea means.

Rail transport: Every movement of freights and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

NST-2007 is a statistical nomenclature for the goods transported by four modes of transport: road, rail, inland waterways and sea (maritime).

The data of maritime, rail and air transport are preliminary and subject to revision. For more information, refer to: <u>Statistical Revision</u> Policy
