


Foreign Trade in Goods

August 2020

Tirana, September 17, 2020: On August 2020 the value of exports was ALL 19 billion, decreasing by 3.4 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 21.1 % compared with July 2020. The value of imports was ALL 48 billion, decreasing by 7.0 % compared with the same period of previous year and by 15.3 % compared with July 2020. This month the trade deficit is ALL 29 billion, decreasing by 9.2 % compared with August 2019 and by 10.9 % compared with July 2020.

Fig.1 Annual change in Foring Trade (%)




In the first eight months of 2020, the value of exports was ALL 169 billion, decreasing by 15.4 %, compared with previous year and the value of imports was ALL 376 billion, decreasing by 12.3 % compared with previous year. Trade deficit was ALL 207 billion, decreasing by 9.7 % compared with the same period of 2019.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual decrease of exports by 3.4 % this month, a negative contribution was given by the groups: "Machinery, equipment spare parts" with -9.2 percentage point, "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -3.6 percentage point, "Chemical and plastical products" with -0.6 percentage point. While a positive contribution was given by the group: "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +0.8 percentage point and "Machinery, equipment spare parts" with +0.1 percentage point.

Fig.2 Contribution of groups in annual change of exports July 2020 (%)




Exports during the first eight months of 2020 are decreased by -15.4 % compared with the same period of previous year. The main groups that influenced more in annual decrease of exports are: "Textile and footware" with -7.4 percentage point, "Construction materials and metals" with -3.6 percentage point, "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -3.5 percentage point. While a positive contribution was given by the group: "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +0.9 percentage point.

The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In annual decrease of imports by 7.0 %, this month has mainly affected the groups: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -4.1 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with -2.0 percentage point, "Construction materials and metals" with -0.8 percentage point. While, a positive contribution was given by the groups: "Textile and footware" with +0.4 percentage point, "Leather and leather manufacture" with +0.1 percentage point.

In the first eight months of 2020, imports are decreased by 12.3 % compared with the same period of previous year. The groups affected negativity in annual increase of imports, are: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with -4.5 percentage point, "Textile and footwear" with -2.7 percentage point, "Machinery, equipment spare parts" with -2.5 percentage point.

The performance of trade in goods by partner countries


In August 2020, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to August 2019 are: Italy (22.1 %), Germany (3.8 %), and Greece (38.6 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of exports are: Kosovo (20.0 %), Spain (27.6 %) and France (80.3 %).

In the first eight months of 2020, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to the same period of 2019 are: Germany (9.3 %), Serbia (15.5 %), and Turkey (23.1 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of exports are: Italy (20.1 %), Kosovo (24.7 %) and Spain (12.8 %).

In August 2020, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to July 2019 are: Italy (2.3 %), Turkey (6.1 %), and USA (3.4 %). While countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: China (11.4 %), Germany (7.2 %) and Greece (2.1 %).

In the first eight months or 2020, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to the same period of 2019 are: Serbia (31.9 %) Russia (28.2 %) and North Macedonia (1.6 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are Italy (16.0 %), China (16.9 %) and Greece (9.0 %).

Trade with the EU countries is 60.3 % of total trade. In August 2020, exports to EU countries occuped 72.9 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 55.2 % of total import. The main trade partners remain: Italy (29.1 %), Turkey (8.0 %), Germany (7.1 %) and China (7.1 %).

Trade with the EU countries, in the first eight months of 2020 is 63.0 % of total trade. In this period, the share of exports to EU countries was 75.2 % of total export and share of imports from EU countries was 57.5 % of total import. The main trade partners are: Italy (31.1 %), Greece (7.7 %), Germany (7.2 %) and Turkey (6.9 %).

Methodology

Exports are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics and for customs tariffs.

Member State of European Union: Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Denmark, Ireland, Greece, Spain, Portugal, Austria, Finland, Sweden, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Bulgaria, Romania, Croatia.
