


# Consumer Price Index

## November, 2020

**Tirana, on December 09, 2020:** Consumer Price Index in November 2020 arrived 107.9 against December 2015 as reference period.

The annual rate of consumer price index in November 2020 is 1.6 %, a year before this rate was 1.4 %. Compared with October 2020, the monthly change of consumer price index in November 2020 is -0.5 %.


**Fig. 1 Annual rate of consumer price index, November 2020**



**Contribution of main groups in yearly changes of CPI:** Annual growth rate in November was influenced mostly from prices of group “Food and non-alcoholic beverage” by +1.44 p.p., followed by “Housing, water, electricity and other fuel” by +0.27 p.p.. Prices of “Furniture household goods and maintenance” group contributed by +0.08 p.p.. Prices of “Miscellaneous goods and services” group contributed by +0.04 p.p.. Prices of “Hotels, coffee-house and restaurants” contributed by +0.03 p.p. Prices of “Alcoholic beverages and tobacco”, “Communication” and “Recreation and culture” groups contributed by +0.02 p.p. each of them. Prices of “Transport” group contributed by -0.29 p.p.. Prices of “Clothing and footwear” group contributed by -0.02 p.p.. Prices of “Health” group contributed by -0.01 p.p..

**Yearly rates of main groups:** Compared to November 2019, prices increased the most in the group “Food and non-alcoholic beverage” by 4.9 %, followed by “Housing, water, electricity and other fuel” by 0.3 %, “Furniture household goods and maintenance” by 1.2 %, “Recreation and culture” and “Miscellaneous goods and services” by 0.9 % each of them, “Hotels, coffee-house and restaurants” by 0.7 %, “Alcoholic beverages and tobacco” by 0.6 %, “Communication” by 0.5 %. On the other hand prices of “Transport” decreased by 4.6 %, followed by “Clothing and footwear” group by 0.3 % and “Health by 0.3 %. Within the food group prices of “vegetables included potatoes” subgroup signed an increased by 13.7 %, followed by “oil and fats” by 4.7 %, “fruit” by 4.3 %, “fish” by 2.7 %, “sugar, jam honey, syrup, chocolates and sweets” by 2.3 %, “milk, cheese and eggs” by 2.2 %, etc.

**Monthly rates of main groups:** Compared with October 2020 prices of “Food and non-alcoholic beverage” decreased by 1.3 %, followed by “Transport” by 0.3 % and “Housing, water, electricity and other fuel” by 0.2 %. On the other hand prices of “Clothing and footwear” increased by 0.4 %, followed by “Alcoholic beverages and tobacco” and “Recreation and culture” by 0.3 % each of them and “Communication” by 0.1 %.

# METHODOLOGY

## - Methodological changes

In January of each year some methodological changes and new developments were carried out in CPI:

- Update of weights: Weights are changed; they are now based on the average expenditure from 2018 Household Budget Survey.
- Update of basket: The list of goods and service content 331 products.
- Update of list of the outlets where the prices are collected is updated.

## - Definitions

The annual rate measures the price change between the current month and the same month of the previous year. This measure is responsive to recent changes in price levels but can be influenced by one-off effect in either month

The monthly rate measures the price change between current month and previous month. Although up-to-date it can be affected by seasonal and other effects.

The 12-month average rate compares average Consumer Price Indices ant the latest 12 month to the average of the previous 12 months.
