



# **Movements of citizens in Albania**

### February 2021

**Tirana, 23 March 2021:** Arrivals of Albanian and foreign citizens to the territory of Albania, in February 2021 are 360,524. Compared to February 2020, this indicator decreased by 41.5 %. In February 2021, arrivals of foreign citizens to the territory of Albania are 158,173. Compared to February 2020, this number decreased by 30.9 %. The number of foreign citizen arrivals to the territory of Albania during the first two months of 2021, is 343,502, decreasing by 28.2 %, compared with the same period of 2020 (tab.1).

During the first two months of 2021, among the countries with the highest inflows of citizens in Albania, Switzerland had the largest increase by 24.5% and Kosovo by 9.8%, while the most significant decrease had Greece by 87.3% and England by 74.7%, compared with the same period of 2020 (tab.2).




Fig. 1 Movements of citizens in Albania, February 2021

Albanian and foreign citizen's departures from the territory of Albania during February 2021 are 371,707 marking a decrease by 41.9 %, compared to the same period of the previous year. Departures of Albanian citizens from the territory of Albania during February 2021 are 228,953. Compared to February 2020, this number has decreased by 41.8 %. Departures of foreign citizens from the territory of Albania during February 2021, this number has decreased by 42.0 % (tab.1).

The number of Albanian citizens leaving the territory of Albania during the first two months of 2021 is 500,637 decreasing by 45,9 %, compared with the same period of 2020 (tab1).

# Methodology

The purpose of the publication for arrivals and departures of Albanian and foreign citizens, by means of transport (sea, air, land and border points), is the measurement of some statistical indicators related to tourism.

### Definitions

Arrivals: Include all entries at the border points (by, air, sea and land).

An arrival is a concept that refers to all entries. A person who visits some countries simultaneously during the year is counted every time as a new entry.

**Departures:** Includes all exits at the border points. Departures measure the flow of citizens who leave the country of reference. A person who leaves the country of reference several times during a year is always counted as a new exit.

**Visitor:** For statistical purposes on tourism, the term "visitor" represents a "person who travels in a different place from that in which he resides, in a period shorter than 12 months and major aim of travel in the place visited is a non-profit activity".

The purpose of the trip includes visits of visitors and tourists for:

Visits for *personal purposes* grouped as follows:

- 1. Holidays, visit to relatives, health treatment, etc.;
- 2. Religious;
- 3. Transit.

Visits for *Business category* include all business and professional activities outside the usual environment.

**Data Source**: Administrative data are provided by the Ministry of Internal Affairs (State Police, Border and Migration Directorate).

The statistical differences between arrivals and departures of Albanian or foreign nationals come mainly from:

- Law No.71 / 2016 "On Border Control", Article 17 "Facilitation of Border Verifications", where during the tourist season or increased inflow, at the moment of entry of citizens at the border, does not register all the incoming citizens;
- The facilitating procedures applied to residents of border areas crossing the border due to their commercial activity, when they cross several times a day, are not registered at the entrance;
- A good share of Albanians hold dual citizenship, who at the time of border crossing June declare different citizenship at exit from it at the entrance, etc.
