


Consumer Price Index

June, 2021

Tirana, on July 08, 2021: Consumer Price Index in June 2021 arrived 101.5 against December 2020 as reference period.


The annual rate of consumer price index in June 2021 is 1.6 %, a year before was 1.8 %. Compared with May 2021, the monthly change of consumer price index in June 2021 is -0.8 %.

Contribution of main groups in yearly changes of CPI: Annual growth rate in June was influenced mostly from prices of group "Food and non-alcoholic beverage" by +0.95 p.p., followed by "Transport" group contributed by +0.13 p.p.. Price of "Housing, water, electricity and other fuel" and "Communication" groups contributed by +0.09 p.p. each of them. Prices of "Furniture household goods and maintenance" group contributed by +0.07 p.p.. Price of "Alcoholic beverages and tobacco" group contributed by +0.06 p.p.. Prices of "Recreation and culture", "Hotels, coffee-house and restaurants" and "Miscellaneous goods and services" groups contributed by +0.05 p.p. each of them. Price of "Clothing and footwear" and "Health" groups contributed by +0.02 p.p. each of them.

Yearly rates of main groups: Compared to June 2020, prices increased the most in the group "Communication" by 2.8 % followed by "Food and non-alcoholic beverage" by 2.7 %, "Transport" by 2.5 %, "Alcoholic beverages and tobacco" by 1.7 %, "Recreation and culture" by 1.4 %, "Hotels, coffee-house and restaurants" by 1.3 %, "Furniture household goods and maintenance" 0.9 %, "Miscellaneous goods and services" by 0.8 %, "Health" by 0.6 %, "Clothing and footwear" and "Housing, water, electricity and other fuel" by 0.5 % each of them, "Education service" by 0.1 %.

Within the food group prices of "vegetables included potatoes" subgroup signed an increased by 10.2 %, followed by "oil and fats" by 6.8 %, "fruits" by 3.9 %, "sugar, jam honey, syrup, chocolates and sweets" by 2.6 %, "milk, cheese and eggs" by 1.9 %, "fish" by 1.4 %, etc.

Monthly rates of main groups: Compared with May 2021 prices of "Food and non-alcoholic beverage" decreased by 2.4 %, followed by group "Clothing and footwear" by 0.2 %. On the other hand prices of "Recreation and culture" group increased by 0.7 %, followed by "Alcoholic beverages and tobacco" by 0.3 %, "Health", "Transport" and "Hotels, coffee-house and restaurants" by 0.2 % each of them, "Miscellaneous goods and services" by 0.1 %.

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Methodology

- Methodological changes

In January of each year some methodological changes and new developments were carried out in CPI:

- Update of weights: Weights are changed; they are now based on the average expenditure from 2018 Household Budget Survey.
- Update of basket: The list of goods and service content 331 products.
- Update of list of the outlets where the prices are collected is updated.

Started from January 2021, the consumer price index is calculated with the new base period. December 2020 is considered as the base period (December 2020 = 100).

INSTAT during the Pandemic period has been following the latest recommendation coming from EUROSTAT and other international partners.

- Definitions

The annual rate measures the price change between the current month and the same month of the previous year. This measure is responsive to recent changes in price levels but can be influenced by one-off effect in either month

The monthly rate measures the price change between current month and previous month. Although upto-date it can be affected by seasonal and other effects.

The 12-month average rate compares average Consumer Price Indices and the latest 12 month to the average of the previous 12 months.
