

Mr. Dema, Director of the Directorate of Coordination and Legal Affairs was appointed to the Institute of Statistics in 2007 and has held the position of head of structures responsible for issues of legislation on official statistics, general administration, procurement, human and financial resource management, etc.

Mr. Dema graduated "Lawyer" in 1995 at the Faculty of Law, University of Tirana. He also completed his postgraduate studies at the Faculty of Economics, University of Tirana, in the branch "Advanced Marketing". In 2011, he completed his post-master studies "Leadership-Career

Management" (Executive Master Level, according to the legislation on high education) at the European University of Tirana.

In 2017, Mr. Dema completed a 5-month traineeship at Eurostat, which has influenced the increase of professional skills in the field of coordination of the National Statistical System and approximation with the acquis communautaire.

On 2020, Mr. Dema was elected Deputy Chairman of the Steering Board.

Since 2017, he is member of the UNECE Task Force for drafting the "Guidance on Modernizing Statistical Legislation". Mr. Dema is also part of the UNECE Expert Group for the Modernization of Statistical Legislation to further improve this manual.

During the period of employment at the Institute of Statistics, in addition to the administrative side, Mr. Dema is also engaged in coordinating European integration processes for Chapter 18 "Statistics" and the preparation of the draft Five-Year Program of Official Statistics and of the Annual Plan for its implementation.
