


# **Foreign Trade in Goods**

## August 2021

**Tirana, September 17, 2021:** On August 2021 the value of exports was ALL 24 billion, increasing by 22.5 % compared with the same period of previous year and decreasing by 26.0 % compared with July 2021. During August 2021, exports increased by 18.9 % compared with monthly average for August period 2018-2020. The value of imports was ALL 61 billion, increasing by 26.2 % compared with the same period of previous year and decreasing by 15.0 % compared with July 2021. On August 2021, imports increased by 23.2 % compared with monthly average for August period 2018-2020. This month the trade deficit is ALL 37 billion, increasing by 28.8 % compared with August 2020 and decreasing by 6.0 % compared with July 2021. On August 2021, trade deficit increased by 26.2 % compared with monthly average for August period 2018-2020.

## Fig.1 Annual change in Foring Trade (%)




In the first eight months of 2021, the value of exports was ALL 232 billion, increasing by 37.3 %, compared with previous year and the value of imports was ALL 487 billion, increasing by 29.3 % compared with previous year. Trade deficit was ALL 254 billion, increasing by 22.8 % compared with the same period of 2020.

### The influence of the main groups in the annual change in exports:

In annual increase of exports by 22.5 % this month, a positive contribution was given by the groups: "Construction materials and metals" with +17.4 percentage point, "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with +8.0 percentage point, and "Machinery, equipment spare parts" with +3.7 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the group: "Textile and footware" with -8.7 percentage point.

In annual increase of exports by 18.9 % this month, compared with the monthly average for August period 2018-2020, a positive contribution was given by the groups: "Construction materials and metals" with +15.8 percentage point, , "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +3.9 percentage point and "Mineral, fuels, electricity" with +2.3 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the group: "Textile and footware" with -5.4 percentage point.

Exports during the first eight months of 2021 are increased by 37.3 % compared with the same period of previous year. The main groups that influenced more in annual increase of exports are: "Construction materials and metals" with +14.2 perecentage point, "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with +11.8 percentage point and "Textile and footware" with +3.8 percentage point.

## The influence of the main groups in the annual change in imports:

In annual increase of imports by 26.2 %, this month has mainly affected the groups: "Minerals, fuels, electricity" with +6.7 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +6.3 percentage point, "Machinery, equipment spare parts" with +5.7 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the group: "Leather and leather manufactures" with -0.1 percentage point.

In annual increase of imports by 23.2% this month, compared with the monthly average for August period 2018-2020, has mainly affected the groups: "Machinery, equipment spare parts" with +5.6 percentage point, "Food, beverages, tobacco" with +5.1 percentage point, "Construction materials and metals" with +4.5 percentage point. While a negative contribution was given by the group: "Leather and leather manufactures" with -0.11 percentage point.

In the first eight months of 2021, imports are increased by 29.3 % compared with the same period of previous year. The groups affected positivity in annual increase of imports, are: "Machinery, equipment spare parts" with +8.5 percentage point, "Construction materials and metals" with +4.8 percentage point, "Chemical and plastical products" with +4.1 percentage point.

#### The performance of trade in goods by partner countries


In August 2021, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to August 2020 are: Kosovo (46.1 %) Germany (23. 8 %) and Macedonia (61.5 %). While, country with which has had a decrease of exports is: Italy (7.5 %) and Spain (13.4 %).

In the first eight months of 2021, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of exports, compared to the same period of 2020 are: Italy (24.9 %), Kosovo (55.3 %) and Spain (35.0 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of exports are: Ukraine (28.5 %) and Russia (36.5 %).

In August 2021, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to August 2020 are: Italy (9.2 %), Turkey (47.5 %) and Germany (50.1 %). While countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Russia (6.9 %), USA (27.8 %) and Switzerland (26.8 %).

In the first eight months or 2021, countries with which Albania has had the highest increase of imports, compared to the same period of 2020 are: Italy (31.4 %), Turkey (48.2 %) and China (27.3 %). While, countries with which has had a decrease of imports are: Russia (8.4 %), Switzerland (25.6 %) and Ukraine (15.8 %).

Trade with the EU countries is 55.1 % of total trade. In August 2021, exports to EU countries occuped 64.7 % of total export and imports from EU countries occuped 51.3 % of total import. The main trade partners remain: Italy (23.7 %), Turkey (9.3 %), Germany (8.2 %) and China (7.0 %).

Trade with the EU countries, in the first eight months of 2021 is 60.7 % of total trade. In this period, the share of exports to EU countries was 71.9 % of total export and share of imports from EU countries was 55.4 % of total import. The main trade partners are: Italy (30.3 %), Turkey (8.0 %), Greece (6.9 %) and Germany (6.8 %).

# Methodology

Foreign Trade of Goods is a periodical publication that presents the trade of Albanian goods with other countries of the world. The data processed by INSTAT for this publication are provided administratively which are obtained from the General Directorate of Customs.

#### **Definitions:**

Exports are goods destined to a third country. placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board) value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed. or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost. insurance and freight (CIF) price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country. or the price of a service delivered to resident. before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

Combined Nomenclature (CN) is a goods nomenclature used by international trade in goods statistics and for customs tariffs.

#### Monthly revisions

The data made available for the last month have an effect also on the revision of the previous months. because with the arrival of data for the last month there are also updated data for previous months as a result of administrative resource updates.
