

Transport statistics*

September 2021

Tirana, 27 October 2021: The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in September 2021 is 435.6 thousand / tonnes, increasing 19.1 % compared to September 2020.

In the nine months of 2021, the volume of freight loading/unloading in ports is 3,676.7 thousand / tonnes, increasing by 18.8 % compared to the nine months of 2020.

The volume of freight transported by rail in September 2021 is 2,331 thousand / tonnes – km, increasing 1.7 % compared to September 2020.

In the nine months of 2021, volume of freights transported by rail is 20,620 thousand tonnes-km, increasing by 10.7 %, compared to the nine months of year 2020.

In September 2021, the volume of freights transported by air is 175.8 tonnes, increasing 10.3 % compared to September 2020.

In the nine months of 2021, the volume of freights transported by air is 1,466.8 tonnes, increasing by 12.5 % compared to the nine months of year 2020.

In September 2021, the number of flights is 3,400 increasing by 2.0 tiems compared to September 2020.

In September 2021, the number of passengers traveling by sea line is 90,342 passengers. Compared to September 2020, this indicator increased by 3.3 times.

In the nine months of 2021, 721,789 passengers travelled by sea, increased by 2.4 times, compared to same period of 2020.

In September 2021, passenger air transport occupies 81.0 % of the total transport.

In September 2021, the number of passengers traveling by air is 390,491 passengers, increased by 3.0 times compared to September 2020.

In the nine months of 2021, the number of passengers traveling by air line is 2,130,936 passengers, increasing by 2.0 times compared to the nine months of year 2020.

Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

In September 2021, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 102.1 billion ALL and 47.8 % of them is transported by sea. In the nine months of 2021, value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 804.2 billion ALL and 48.6 % of them is transported by sea.

Exports of goods

In September 2021, goods exported by sea represent 56.1 %, by road 38.3 % and by air 0.4 % of total exports of goods. Goods exported by road increased by 18.6 %, compared with the same period of 2021.



In the nine months of 2021, goods exported by sea represent 54.3 %, by road 38.6 % and by air 0.5 %. Goods exported by road increased by 19.9 % compared to same period of 2020.

Imports of goods

In September 2021, goods imported by road represent 44.6 %, by sea 43.8 % and by air 2.9 %. Goods imported by road in September 2021 increased by 21.1 %, compared to September 2020.



In the nine months of 2021, goods imported by road represented 47.2 %, by sea 45.8 % and by air 3.9 %. Goods imported by road increased by 23.8 %, compared with the same period of 2020.

Methodology

The Publication of Transport Statistics presents the results on the transport of goods and passengers by type, as well as the export and import of goods by mode of transport, on a monthly basis. The data are administrative. The main source of information is the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy and General Directorate of Customs.

Definitions

Airlines: Companies that transport passengers and goods.

Transport: Movement of people and / or frnines using various means of transport. Transport is carried out by land, air and sea means.

Rail transport: Every movement of frnines and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track,

Maritime transport: Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

Air transport: Any movement of frnines and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

Exports: Goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

The FOB (free on board): Value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

Imports: Goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

The cost, insurance and frnine (CIF): Price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

NST 2007: A statistical nomenclature for the goods transported by four modes of transport: road, rail, inland waterways and sea (maritime).

The data of maritime, rail and air transport are preliminary and subject to revision. For more refer: Statistical revision policy.
