Snapshot: ESSPROS Study Visit to Latvia and expert missions on National Accounts SPs

A study visit to Statistics Latvia took place from 21 to 22 August 2025 in the frame of SP 4.3 ESSPROS and brought together statistical experts from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro, and Türkiye to explore best practices in social protection statistics. The study visit focused on understanding Latvia's ESSPROS system, including the collection and processing of core data, pension beneficiaries, and net social benefits. The expert from the Central Statistical Bureau of Latvia shared practical insights, giving participants a firsthand look at how social protection data is gathered, processed, and analysed.

During the visit, participants learned about the links between ESSPROS and National Accounts data, which help identify potential data sources and validate figures. Partner countries gained detailed knowledge on the

methodology and operations of the ESSPROS system, including estimations, data sources, and reporting processes.

By observing Latvia's approach, the participants were able to discuss common challenges and solutions in implementing ESSPROS, particularly in handling quantitative and module-specific data.

The experience highlighted the importance of cooperation between statistical institutions and relevant ministries, as seen in Latvia's collaboration between the Central Statistical Bureau and the Ministry of Welfare. Participants observed how ESSPROS statistics are communicated to stakeholders through publications and press releases, and how the system continuously improves through careful monitoring and validation.

Overall, the study visit provided practical knowledge and inspiration for all participating countries. By adopting similar approaches, including comprehensive municipal surveys on social service expenditures, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, and Türkiye can improve data coverage and quality, ensuring that their social protection statistics meet international standards and support evidence-based policymaking.

In parallel to the study visit to Latvia, several expert missions were carried out across the region under the IPA 2022 contract, advancing work in the areas of national accounts and sector accounts. In Podgorica, expert supported the Statistical Office of Montenegro in strengthening methodologies for balances of inventories and sector accounts, while in Kosovo, missions focused on developing quarterly GDP estimates and successfully applying the Labour Input Method to capture informal employment, providing KAS with a complete and operational model to feed into the 2026 benchmark revision. In Albania, significant progress was made towards establishing a functional system for Quarterly Sector Accounts, including the preparation of backcasts for earlier years, while in Türkiye, the first additional mission enabled the compilation and balancing of who-to-whom matrices for distributive transactions, ensuring stronger foundations for future quarterly sector accounts. Meanwhile, in Serbia, the first mission for under Supply, Use and Input-Output Tables (SUIOT) set out a comprehensive work plan to improve timeliness, metadata, and SDMX-based transmissions. Collectively, these missions demonstrated how targeted technical support helps beneficiary countries further develop statistical production aligned with ESA 2010 requirements.
